

Hon. Secretary's Annual Report for Year 2024

Warm Greetings to Members & Supporters of the Society!

The year 2024 have been a busy year for the Society, as we try hard to meet the Mission of the Society ie.to protect and improve on the welfare of animals.

We work this goal by:

- Providing Shelter & Food
- Giving Medical Care & attention to animals in need
- Advocating for better animal welfare laws & enforcement
- Educating the public about the importance of respecting animals; AND ensuring they live healthy, happy & dignified -free from pain & suffering. Or at least given proper treatment, care & love to minimize their discomfort & suffering.

I have great pleasure in presenting to you the **Annual Report FYE 2024**; which provides an overview of our work in the past year:

- 1) We welcomed many new animals into our **Shelter**
- 2) We were invited to engage for better **Animal Welfare Laws** in Coalition with others under an Official platform known as Gabungan NGO Haiwan Malaysia,
- 3) We held dozens of **Education** events with Colleges & Universities, to create awareness on Animal cruelty, animal welfare & rights, TNR programs and Industrial Training ground.
- 4) We organized / co-organized **Fund Raising** Social events or programs collaborating with Companies, Colleges, International Schools & Universities.

ANIMALS IN THE SHELTER

Year 2024, in comparison to Dogs & puppies received which has been abandoned or collected, the shelter received a surge in abandoned Cats & Litters of kittens! Many were surrendered / dumped by the public; or collected by us upon receiving numerous complaints from residential communities, irritated neighbours, stakeholders @ eateries who wish to keep their business premises clean and hygienic for their patrons to enjoy their meals.

One of the major reasons the number of CATs outnumber the canines are due to their BREEDING RATES which are faster than dogs.

Hence, the Shelter always advise and educate the public to help NEUTER these animals to prevent an explosion to their population. Instead of merely feeding the stray cats/kittens, the public is strongly urged to neuter these strays before returning them to their original environment found or picked up. (# Unfortunately, not everyone is keen to release them back to its environment, which leaves SPCA no option but to release them in areas where there is "food Source"

ADOPTION rate @ the Shelter is low in 2024, with Dogs & puppies (36) and Cats/Kittens (29)
The continuing Low Rate with each passing year is partly contributed by:

- A) TIGHT BUDGET - faced by the public due to Inflation and High Cost of Living.

- B) **DEMOGRAPHIC** – younger & more of the population moving to high rise buildings in comparison to previous decades, where families live together in residential Landed properties.

NEUTERING

During the year, a total of 155 dogs and cats were neutered and vaccinated through our Neutering Fund. At year end, SPCA was in collaboration with the Rotaract Club of Tanjong Bungah with the trap neuter release (TNR project) on stray cats. To be able to achieve the control of population of stray animals, there must be at least 70-80% commitment from all parties.
