ANIMALS IN THE SHELTER

FYE 2025, we recorded 436 strays (386 cats & 50 dogs) picked/brought in to the shelter. It's obvious that cats outnumbered the dogs in many folds.

Healthy cats were arranged to be neutered and released back as much as possible. Others were put up for adoption whilst those diseased /badly injured were humanely euthanized.

ANIMAL DOPTION

The rate of adoption remains low. A total of 49 forever homes were found FYE 2025, after ensuring Adopters are discretely qualified and capable of committing lifetime caring for their adopted pet dog or cat. We discourage failures as when they are returned, the possibility of rehoming is difficult.

We like to thank Star Feature Writer Ms. Ellen Whyte for giving us the publicity to highlight our animals for adoption each month. Her thoughts and contribution towards the society was indeed applaudable.

NEUTERING

Efforts are made to ensure that healthy adult stray cats brought in will be neutered and released back to where it came from. However, sadly members of the public who brought strays in are reluctant to return them to where it comes from. This makes it difficult for us to look for avenues where they can be released at food source. All cats neutered are ear notched in a way to identify that they have been neutered and not taken away.

SPCA has also tackled problems faced by high rise Management Committee where cats are found roaming and pro-creating. Our shelter is not a sanctuary and as such we are unable to cater for the large population of stray cats. Hence, we engage collaboration with the residents provided they are willing to TRAP, SPCA will NEUTER and residents need to RELEASE back.

SPCA has disposed off our Animal Ambulance Van due to high cost maintenance and inability to have a Driver. (our Animal Welfare Officer cum Driver fell ill)

We have purchased a 2nd hand MPV to saVe cost whilst continuing with the rescue work upon request by the public.
