Animals Collected

There was an overall decrease in the total number of animals passing through SPCA in 2016 as compared to 2015 (2015 figures shown in brackets below). Though the numbers brought in by the public and surrendered by owners show little change, the ambulance collected a lot less animals in 2016 than in 2015. Although this appears positive, we feel the reduction is due to an increase in other shelter/sanctuaries in the State rather than the fact that the number of stray animals has been reduced.
