**Neutering Fund**

A total of 31 animals were neutered from this fund during the year. To avoid the spread of diseases at the shelter, it is compulsory that all animals kept for rehoming undergo a routine veterinary check before putting up for adoption etc. This neutering fund is also utilized to cover expenses for routine vaccination shots upon admission to the shelter. The balance in the fund at year end was RM3077.
